What is a conditional sentence?

It's a sentence that shows a condition and a result.

- There are two parts in a conditional sentence: the condition clause and the result clause.

Examples:

- If I **study** for the exam, I **will get** a good score.
- If Luis **finishes** his homework, he **will go** out to the park.
- In the **condition clause**, we are going to use the **Present Simple Tense** and in the **result clause**, we are going to use **“will + verb”**

- If you **eat** vegetables for lunch, you **will be** a healthy boy.

Will + verb
